Traveling to St. Louis

Numerous airlines fly into Lambert-St Louis International Airport from most major US cities, and many international points of departure. See www.flystl.com for flights. We recommend that you do not make your air travel reservations until you have reserved a space in the class. Please contact TTI before making your reservations, and do not book non-refundable tickets.

Driving Instructions

To reach the Crowne Plaza from the airport, head northwest on Departing Flights/Terminal Access Rd toward Lambert International Blvd. Turn left at Lambert International Blvd, then take Interstate 70 west to exit 235A-B for Lindbergh Blvd/US-67. Keep left at the fork to continue toward exit 235A for Lindbergh Blvd/US-67 S. Turn right at Lone Eagle Dr. Destination will be on the right. Total distance is 2.6 miles.
